• Additional Card Fee:	<b>\$10.00</b> per card.
<b>Transaction Fees</b>	
• Balance Transfer:	Either <b>\$5.00</b> or <b>2.00%</b> of the amount of each transfer, whatever is greater(maximum fee <b>\$500.00</b> .)
• Cash Advance:	Either <b>\$2.00</b> or <b>2.00%</b> of the amount of each advance, whatever is greater.
• International Transaction:	None
<b>Penalty Fees</b>	
• Late Payment:	Up to <b>\$25.00</b> if your payment is more than 5 days late.
• Over-the-Credit Limit:	None
• Returned Payment:	Up to <b>\$25.00</b> if your payment is returned for any reason.
