Application Qualifications and Instructions

To qualify for this Scholarship Program, the applicant must...

- currently be a resident of Sonoma, Marin, Napa or Solano County
- have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.50
- be no older than 23 years of age
- **must be a current member of North Bay Credit Union**
- currently be attending or going to attend any post high school accredited tech school, university, college or specialized educational course **with a field of study related to technical or trade services**

When submitting your application, the applicant must...

- ☐ provide a completed application
- ☐ provide **two** letters of recommendation referencing the applicant's character, responsibility, citizenship, and financial need.
- ☐ provide an **OFFICIAL** copy of school transcript (online printouts will **not** be accepted!)

All of these materials should be submitted at the same time

Top applicants must attend an interview to be scheduled in July;
applicants will be contacted with time and date.

Applications, letters of recommendation and official transcripts must be received on or before 5:00 PM, Friday, June 10, 2022!
