- 1. Two Midland Empire Chapter Scholarship awards will be granted in the amount of \$1,000 each.
- 2. Eligibility: The applicant must be a member of a Credit Union within the Midland Empire Chapter fields of membership. These scholarships apply to any accredited college, graduate school, or secondary education facility.
- 3. Traditional Student Scholarship: One scholarship will be awarded to a traditional student, defined as a graduating high school senior or someone in college with less than a three-year gap since high school. Ray Harris Memorial Scholarship: One scholarship will be awarded to a non-traditional student, defined as someone who was out of school for at least three years and has returned.
- **4. Due Date:** Completed applications and all required materials must be submitted to your credit union no later than **March 1st.** Scholarships will be awarded at the April chapter meeting of the Midland Empire Chapter of Credit Unions.

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- **6.** The applicant's signature is required for completion of this form. By signing this form, the applicant authorizes the Midland Empire Chapter to use their photo for media publishing.
- 7. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
