TriStar Bank realizes the need to encourage and recognize all students in excelling to their highest academic potential in both grades and attendance. We therefore are offering “The TriStar Bank \*Star\* Student Savings Program.” This plan was conceived to encourage, help develop, and to reward our students, K- 12, who perform their best in academics and attendance.

The TriStar Bank \*Star\* Student Savings Program is a very simple program. Bring your child in to TriStar Bank to open their savings account. Identification will be needed from all account holders to open the account. Forms of identification accepted include but are not limited to the social security card, birth certificate, student ID card, firearm license, passport, or state driver’s license. Within one (1) week of report cards being issued to the student, bring your child and their report card to the bank and show one of our employees the report card in order to receive one dollar (\$1.00) for each “A” up to five (5) “A’s”, for Kindergarten students an “X”, and 1st and 2nd grade a “2+”. Showing the actual report card is the only way your child may receive the deposit. The money must be deposited into their TriStar Youth Savings Account. The money must remain in their savings account until June 30 of the current school year. You or your child may make other deposits into this account at any time. The last day to bring in your report card is June 30, 2023.

On top of getting great grades, perfect attendance will earn your child an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) each new report card time also. There must not be any excused or unexcused absences or tardies. It must be “perfect” attendance. If any missed absences occur on a student’s record within the current report card time, it will automatically disqualify the student from receiving the perfect attendance additional funds that particular report card period, but they may try again the next period. Virtual learners and home school students will also qualify for the attendance award.

TriStar Bank wishes to encourage all students to participate in this savings program. Along with getting great grades and earning extra money for attendance, your child may be introduced to earning and saving money for the first time. We at TriStar Bank want to share this experience with them. Please encourage your child to take part in this reward program.
