Names of other HFCU members may be added to the ballot by using the following procedures:

1. Eligible HFCU members must obtain an application and a biographical data form from HFCU by contacting President/CEO Joseph Marchese at 717-533-9174 ext.125 or [jmarchese@hersheyfcu.org](mailto:jmarchese@hersheyfcu.org).
2. The petitioning member must obtain signatures from at least 1% (67) of valid and eligible HFCU members.
3. The member must complete the application and biographical data form.
4. The member must then return the completed application, biographical data form, and the list of signatures to Joseph Marchese, President/CEO, by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 20, 2020.

On Monday, March 23, 2020 the applications will be verified. Only qualified members in good financial standing with HFCU will be accepted and added to the ballot. The completed ballot with biographical data of all nominees will be posted in the HFCU offices on Wednesday, March 25, 2020.

The ballot will be presented at the HFCU Annual Meeting on Wednesday, April 29, 2020. HFCU members with a deposit of at least one share (\$5) and who are at least 18 years old are eligible to vote. If a vote is needed, each member is allowed only one vote, regardless of the number of accounts or amount of shares. There will be no off-site ballot boxes or proxy vote. You must be present to vote.
