Notice of Annual Meeting and Election of Officers

The Grand Altitude Federal Credit Union Annual Meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 13, 2026, at 5 PM** at the **Lander Community Center at 950 Buena Vista Drive in Lander, Wyoming**. The election of directors **will not** be held at the meeting **but will be conducted before the meeting**. If an election is necessary, an election ballot will be mailed or emailed out in June.

Per Article V of the Grand Altitude's Bylaws, a Nominating Committee was appointed by the Chairwoman and has reported that the following credit union members have been nominated to fill **three** positions on the Board of Directors. The nominees are **Jullie Shull, Don Schmidt, and Mike Jones**. All three nominees are for 3-year terms.

Also, according to Article V, any eligible member may petition for election by obtaining signatures of at least 1% of the Membership. One percent of the Membership is **128**. The Secretary of the Board must receive any Petition for Nomination, a statement of qualifications, and biographical data before **July 3, 2026**.

Enclosed with this notice are statements of qualifications and biographical data on each nominee and a Petition for Nomination for anyone interested in running for a board position against the **three** nominees.

Jullie Shull
