

## Financial Focus



With the holiday season reaching an end and spending obligations coming to a halt, there is no better time to get hold of your finances and plan for the future than now. If your New Year's resolution for 2022 is to improve your finances, consider setting these five goals.

#### 1. Create a Budget

Creating a budget helps establish guidelines for what you can afford to spend and helps identify areas where you could cut back. To get started, determine how much money you make a month after taxes. Once you have that number, calculate the amount you need to cover your fixed monthly expenses such as your rent or mortgage and other costs such as your cell phone payment, groceries, and gas. Once these expenses are paid for, any money left over can be put towards other goals or investments.

#### 2. Build a Savings

Once you have a budget, you will know where your money is going and how much you can potentially put away each month. It is often suggested to commit 20% of your monthly income to savings. Any money saved can be used for a long-term goal or an emergency

fund. Signing up for automatic transfers with Firelands FCU may also help you save. You can do this by logging into your Firelands FCU online banking account or mobile banking app and clicking "Transfer Money." (OCLNI J RUBETL)

#### 3. Build your Credit

Many life decisions revolve around your credit, like getting an apartment, buying a car, or taking out a mortgage, so building a good credit score is an important goal to set. Some ways to build your score include:

- Paying your loans on time, every time.
- Keeping your credit card balances low.
- Checking your credit report for errors.

#### 4. Manage your Debt

Certain types of debt, such as high-interest credit card debt, can hinder your ability to pursue long-term financial goals. Keep your debt under control by staying aware of where your debt is coming from and by determining how much extra you may be able to devote from your budget to debt reduction. You may also consider consolidating your debt or scheduling an appointment with Firelands FCU to discuss your debt concerns and hear what programs we may have available to help.

#### 5. Prepare for Retirement

The sooner you start saving for your retirement, the more secure you will be when the time comes. If you're employed, it may be beneficial for you to have a conversation with your human resources department to see what accounts they may have to offer.
