




### MONDAY, FEBRUARY 5



## NAIROBI - OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY - TO THE FOOT OF MOUNT KENYA

Africa's Drive north out of the city to **Ol Pejeta Conservancy**, the largest rhino sanctuary in all East Africa. After lunch, embark on a **game drive** to begin your search for the "Big 5"—lion, leopard, elephant, rhino, and Cape buffalo. End the day with a welcome barbeque in the bush.

### TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 6



### OL PEJETA - SAFARI SENSATION

Morning game drive with beautiful **Mount Kenya**. Beyond the "Big 5," you may spot cheetahs, zebra, gazelle, etc. You might even spot rare wild dogs. After some downtime and lunch, visit the **Sweetwaters Chimp Sanctuary** then set out on an afternoon game drive. Dinner at camp concludes your first full day on safari!

### WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 7



## OL PEJETA-NYAHURURU FALLS-LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK - HIGH AND MIGHTY

Leave Ol Pejeta and journey through the beautiful **Kenyan highlands**, one of the most fertile agricultural areas in all of Africa. Stop at scenic **Nyahururu Falls** and then on to **Lake Nakuru National Park** for an afternoon game drive and a chance to see giraffe, impala, flamingo, striped hyena, and a variety of birdlife along the water's edge.

### THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 8



## LAKE NAKURU-MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE - JEWEL OF KENYA

Depart for Maasai Mara National Reserve, Kenya's most famous game area. "The Mara," as it is called by locals, is part of the Serengeti ecosystem and boasts a strong permanent population of game. When the Great Migration of wildebeest and zebra arrives, typically from August to early November, their population grows by almost 2 million - a bountiful food source for predators such as lion, cheetah, leopard, and hyena. After lunch at your lodge, set out on an afternoon game drive.

### FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 9



### MAASAI MARA - MAGICAL MARA

Morning game drive including an **exclusive bush breakfast**. Watch for elephants, rhinos, giraffes, topi, hyenas, and much more. Return to your camp and relax prior to your afternoon game drive.

After breakfast, fly to **Amboseli National Park** (via Nairobi), known for spectacular views of **Mount Kilimanjaro** or "Kili", the highest mountain in Africa. Go on an afternoon game drive before settling in at your lodge.

### SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 11

### ADVENTURE IN AMBOSELI



Morning and afternoon game drives are included today. Amboseli affords you a terrific opportunity to get close to the mighty elephant. You might also spot Cape buffalo, zebra, wild dog, and more. Stop for sundowner drinks prior to returning to your lodge for dinner.

### MONDAY. FEBRUARY 12

AMBOSELI-ARUSHA, TANZANIA-LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK - BORDER DUTIES & INTO TANZANIA



This morning, cross into **Tanzania**. Enjoy lunch in **Arusha**. Lodge along the rim of the Great Rift Valley. Enjoy leisure time prior to dinner.


### TUESDAY. FEBRUARY 13

LAKE MANYARA-KARATU-NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA - FROM FOREST FLOOR TO CRATER'S EDGE



**Lake Manyara National Park** is a park with groundwater forests, grassy plains, and Lake Manyara itself. Home to the world's largest concentration of baboons. Look for them on the morning game drive. Journey to Karatu to visit a primary school. Lodge on the rim of Ngorongoro Crater, which is part of the larger Ngorongoro Conservation.

### NGORONGORO - INTO AFRICA'S EDEN



Descend into the crater for a full-day game drive. Ngorongoro Crater is technically a caldera—the world's largest unflooded one, in fact—at more than 2,000 feet deep with a floor covering over 102 square miles. Game viewing here is fantastic, as most of the animals stay in this area year-round. You can see a lion, Cape buffalo, hippo, elephant, and more. This is also your best chance to see the rare black rhinoceros. An exclusive bush lunch will be served in the crater.

### THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 15



### NGORONGORO-SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

- ON THE ENDLESS PLAINS

Drive to Serengeti National Park. Lunch at your camp before an afternoon game drive. You have the chance to see the big cats—lion, leopard, and cheetah—as well as the Nile crocodile, giraffe, gazelle, and eland. You may even something rare, like a caracal, a beautiful cat with distinctive ears.

### FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16



### SERENGETI - SERENGETI SERENDIPITY


Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives. The Serengeti attracts visitors from around the world and is great for year-round game viewing. Tonight, join a farewell dinner in the bush featuring a traditional Maasai

One final game drive before flying back to Arusha, where a day room has been reserved for your use.
