## **DAY 2 - BOSTON'S HISTORIC FREEDOM TRAIL, PLYMOUTH, AND CAPE COD**

After breakfast, set off for a guided tour of Historic Boston and the birthplace of American Freedom! You'll tour along Boston's Freedom Trail, viewing many historic sites and hearing tales of the brave Bostonians and Colonialists who dared to challenge Britain and helped establish the greatest republic in the world. Midday, enjoy lunch on your own and free time at historic Faneuil Hall Marketplace, as alive today as in 1742 when our nation's fathers proclaimed it "The Cradle of Liberty." This afternoon, continue south touring through America's Hometown of Plymouth for a brief tour viewing the Plymouth Rock, Plymouth Waterfront, and Mayflower II Replica. Continue to Cape Cod for a tour through the historic village of Sandwich - Cape Cod's oldest town settled in 1637 and the "town that glass built." Enjoy this charming village and visit the historic Sandwich Glass Museum for a glass-blowing demonstration! Breathe the salty sea air and feel the coastal breezes as we arrive at the Red Jacket Beach Resort, overlooking beautiful Nantucket Sound, for a relaxing five-night stay. Enjoy a guided tour of Oak Bluffs which is noted for its collection of small Carpenter Gothic cottages clustered in the Methodist Camp Meeting Grounds and Edgartown are known for their stately Greek revival homes built by sea captains of years ago. Return to the mainland after a full day of sightseeing and enjoy a planned dinner together.

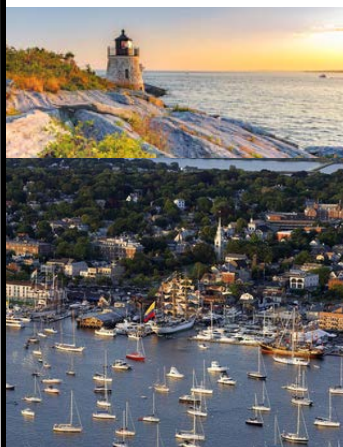
