MONDAY, DECEMBER 1 (Dinner)

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 4 (Pizza Lunch)

Visit the Brooklyn waterfront in DUMBO for the best selfies with the Brooklyn Bridge! Enjoy award-winning Neapolitan pizza at **Grimaldi's** under the Brooklyn Bridge, and legendary Sicilian-style pizza at **L&B Spumoni Gardens** in Bensonhurst. This multimedia sightseeing tour highlights Brooklyn's many neighborhoods, parks, landmarks, and famous movie locations. We'll visit **Coney Island** for an opportunity to stroll its famous boardwalk overlooking the Atlantic Ocean.
