



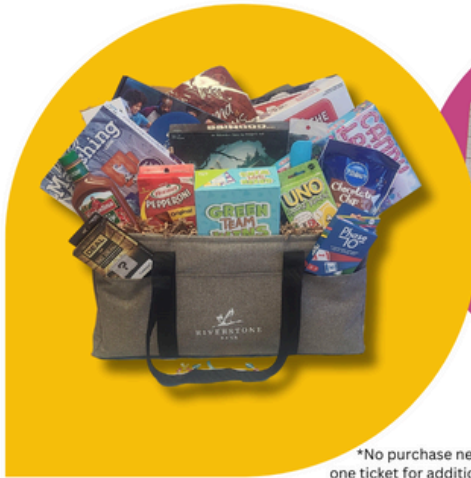

If you're heading out of town, ask the post office to hold your mail until you return.



Contact the sender if you don't receive mail that you're expecting.



Consider buying security envelopes to conceal the contents of your mail.

### Protect yourself by protecting your checks and mail

- Use pens with indelible (gel or permanent) ink so it is more difficult to wash out.
- Don't leave blank spaces in the payee or amount line.
- Don't include personal detail (SSN, credit card #, DL info or phone # on checks.
- Review your statements regularly for errors or inconsistent activity.
- Use online/mobile banking to review the back of checks to ensure the indorsements match intended payee--sometimes the criminals will deposit unaltered checks.
- Use e-check, automatic payments (ACH) or other electronic means when possible.
- Follow up with payees to make sure they received the check.

- ✉️ Don't leave mail in the box overnight
- ✉️ Place a hold on mail, if you will be out of town
- ✉️ Sign up for informed delivery
- ✉️ Use security envelopes
- ✉️ Use the letter slots inside the post office when sending mail

Fraudsters are targeting paper checks sent through the mail. Once they have a check that you mailed, they use chemicals to "wash" the check allowing them to change the amount or make themselves the payee. Then, they deposit or cash your check and steal your money.

Postal Inspectors across the country work hard to protect your mail. Help Postal Inspectors keep the mail safe by following these tips.

## WHAT TO DO IF YOU'RE A VICTIM?

### File a report immediately with:

- ✓ Your bank and request copies of all fraudulent checks
- ✓ Your local police department
- ✓ The United States Postal Inspection Service at [uspis.gov/report](https://uspis.gov/report) or call 1-877-876-2455
