Lincoln-Douglas Square

Abraham Lincoln (pictured right) was the 16th President of the United States, from 1861-1865. He was in office during the Civil War.

But before that, he wished to run for the Senate against Stephen A. Douglas. The two were involved in seven debates, the last of which took place in Alton in October of 1858.

Douglas won the election for senator, and just two years later Lincoln was elected president.

This spot in downtown Alton depicts the debate on the very place where it occurred so long ago.
