### “San Antonio Christmas”

November 28 – December 2, 2022

Stay four nights right in the center of all the action on San Antonio’s famous Riverwalk! Explore the area’s rich history including three Missions, an authentic Mexican Marketplace, and The Alamo. Visit the Lyndon B. Johnson National Historic Park and his boyhood home before arriving in Stonewall and the LBJ Ranch and Texas White House. You will travel to Bandera, the “Cowboy Capital of the World” and visit the Frontier Times Museum. The last evening, enjoy a farewell dinner followed by a leisurely cruise along the Paseo del Rio beautifully decorated for the holidays. **NEW TOUR!**



### “Legacy of the Incas – Peru”

March 14 – 25, 2023

Begin your adventure in Lima, Peru with a tour of the city’s colonial heritage viewing the Plaza de Armas, San Francisco Monastery, and more! Fly to Cusco, the impressive Andean city that was once the capital of the Inca Empire. Head into the Sacred Valley of the Incas and experience a mystical El Pago a la Tierra, or Mother Earth Ceremony. Visit the Inca Fortress of Ollantaytambo before boarding the Vistadome Train for a short journey through the lush Urubamba Valley and arriving at Machu Picchu, the “Lost City of the Incas”. You will head back to Cusco where you will visit the semi-circular Kenko Temple and the ancient site of Puca Pucara before heading to the Temple of Sacsayhuaman perched on a hillside overlooking Cusco. You will then board a flight to Juliaca where you will continue to Puno on the shores of Lake Titicaca. Take a motorboat trip to some of the more unique islands of Lake Titicaca including the Uros Islands. Fly back to Lima and drive along the Pan-American highway to the Bay of Paracas. Embark on a cruise out to the Ballestas Islands, which are inhabited by a wide variety of sea mammals and exotic birds. Board a plane for flightseeing over the Nazca plains as your pilot points out the mysterious markings known as the Nazca Lines. Enjoy a farewell dinner in Lima before returning home.


