



Premier Club **Mackinac & the Great Lakes**

7 Days, 6 Nights
September 19 – 25, 2022



Day One – Monday, September 19th: Chicago, IL (D)

Depart the Boise airport today for your flight to Chicago this afternoon. Arrive at O'Hare airport, meet your Tour Director and board the motor coach for the short ride to your hotel. This evening, enjoy a welcome dinner.



Day Two – Tuesday, September 20th: Chicago & Holland, MI (B, D).

This morning, meet your local guide for a tour of the Windy City. Sights include Hancock Tower, Willis Tower, Old Water Tower, Magnificent Mile, Navy Pier, and more. Then make your way to the west side of the state and Lake Michigan shoreline. Arrive in Saugatuck later today. Afterwards, board the special dune buggy for a fun ride over the massive sand dunes. Continue to Holland and check in for the night. Enjoy the beautiful tulip gardens and the Old Dutch windmill in town.



Day Three – Wednesday, September 21st: Mackinaw City, MI (B, D)

Travel north today along Lake Michigan; this is cherry country. Bing cherries are a major crop for the region. You will stop along the way to taste some of these wonderful little berries. In Traverse City, you will tour the Acme Music Box Museum. Some of the oldest music boxes in the world are found here. Your day continues with a drive across the northern portion of the state to Mackinaw City. Check into your hotel for the next two nights before dinner.



Day Four – Thursday, September 22nd: Mackinac Island Sightseeing (B, L)

After a full breakfast, take the ferry to Mackinac Island. On arrival, experience a horse drawn carriage tour of the island featuring Arch Rock, Surrey Hills, Skull Cave, and more. At the changing station, switch to a smaller carriage and complete the island tour. The tour will end at the famous Grand Hotel where you will enjoy lunch in the Grand Dining Room. After lunch you are treated to a tour of the famous 133-year-old hotel. The balance of the afternoon is free to visit the town and the landing to shop and stroll. Two well-known shops are the Mackinac Island Fudge Shop and the Mackinac Kite Store – both are fun visits. Later, return by ferry to Mackinaw City for dinner on your own.



Day Five – Friday, September 23rd: Frankenmuth, MI (B, D)

After breakfast, travel south through Bay City and Saginaw to the Bavarian style town of Frankenmuth. Here you will have a guided tour of the town featuring the Clock Tower and St. Lorenz Lutheran Church. Then enjoy shopping and viewing the world's largest full time Christmas store at Bonner's. If you want it for Christmas, Bonner's is the place to find it! Later check into your local hotel for the night. This evening, enjoy a traditional German chicken dinner with all the trimmings.



Day Six – Saturday, September 24th: Henry Ford Museum (B, D)

Travel south from Frankenmuth to Dearborn. Here you will visit the vast Henry Ford Museum. Many beautiful cars and other mechanical wonders are on display as well as a vintage Air Stream Trailer and the first Holiday Inn sign in America. Afterwards check into your local hotel for the night. This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner.



Day Seven – Sunday, September 25th: Homeward Bound (B)

An early departure finds you on the way to the Detroit airport where you will board your flight to Boise. Arrive late this afternoon where your Mackinac & Great Lakes Tour will conclude.

D.L. Evans Bank Premier Club tours are assigned activity ratings from level 1 to level 5. Please consider the following statements and at what level you are comfortable traveling when booking your tour:

LEVEL 1:

I like to keep walking to a minimum and avoiding stairs when I can. I can walk up to a mile per day over primarily level ground with short periods of standing.

LEVEL 2:

I'm comfortable walking one to two miles throughout the day. I expect to get on and off of a motor coach, and I'm ready to stroll through cities and walk over uneven pavement. I can stand for up to 30 minutes and climb one to two flights of stairs.

LEVEL 3:

I like to spend much of the day exploring and be out and about on a coach with my days full. I can walk two to three miles per day and stand for long periods of time with no difficulty. Stairs don't bother me, and I love to keep up with the group.

LEVEL 4:

I am a fit traveler and am capable of easily walking three miles or more during the day. I would like my days to be filled with active pursuits for one to three hours at a time. I can walk on uneven and rocky terrain, including small hills.

LEVEL 5:

Walking is the best way to get to know a new place. I'm energetic and enjoy a challenge. I'm always ready to spend the day on the move. I am fine with uneven surfaces, inclines, stair climbing, windy or wet conditions at sites, and long periods of standing. I expect some of the experiences to occur in the evening with very long days.

Mackinac & the Great Lakes Tour has an activity **LEVEL of 3.**
