

Premier Club Pendleton Wild West Getaway May 18 - 20, 2022



May 18th:

Depart today for our two-night three-day Wild West Getaway! We will travel west through southern Idaho and into Oregon. Stops will be made in Idaho Falls, Pocatello, Burley, Twin Falls, and Boise to pick up fellow club members. Our destination will be Pendleton, Oregon, and the Wildhorse Resort & Casino. We will arrive in time to check-in to your room and freshen up before a catered buffet dinner at the hotel.

Pendleton is a city in Umatilla County, Oregon. Developed along the Umatilla River, the town was named in 1868 by the county commissioners for George H. Pendleton. A European-American commercial



the county commissioners for George H. Pendleton. A European-American commercial center began to develop here in 1851, when Dr. William C. McKay established a trading post at the mouth of McKay Creek. Over the years, Pendleton has become the cultural center of Eastern Oregon. The Wildhorse Resort is located on the Umatilla Indian Reservation and is run by a confederation of three Sahaptin-speaking Native American tribes who traditionally inhabited the Columbia River Plateau region: the Cayuse, Umatilla, and Walla Walla.

After dinner, there will be time for gambling or exploring the resort before a good night's sleep in our luxury accommodations. (D)

May 19th:

We will enjoy a hearty breakfast at one of the resort's restaurants before we board the motor coach for a tour of Pendleton's Underground Tunnels*. After the tour we will have lunch on our own in Pendleton's "Old Town" before continuing to the Pendleton Woolen Mill and the Heritage Museum.

By 1900, Pendleton had a population of 4,406 and was the fourth-largest city in Oregon. The Pendleton Woolen Mills and Pendleton Round Up became features of the city captured in early paintings by Walter S. Bowman. Like many cities in Eastern Oregon, where thousands of Chinese immigrant workers built the transcontinental railroad, it had a flourishing Chinatown that developed as the workers settled here and the sector was underlain by a network of tunnels. The Pendleton Underground Tour takes you through the tunnels dug up by the Chinese to carry out their illegal activities.



After a day of learning about Pendleton's interesting past, we will have time to freshen up at the resort before we conclude the day with dinner at Hamley's Steak House. (B,D)

May 20th:

Breakfast is at your leisure this morning before boarding the motor coach to Baker City, Oregon for a city tour and lunch on our own.

Platted in 1865, Baker City grew slowly in the beginning. A post office was established on March 27, 1866, but Baker

City was not incorporated until 1874. The city and county were named in honor of U.S.



City was not incorporated until 1874. The city and county were named in honor of U.S. Senator Edward D. Baker, the only sitting senator to be killed in a military engagement. He died in 1861 while leading a charge of 1,700 Union Army soldiers up a ridge at Ball's Bluff, Virginia, during the American Civil War. The Oregon Short Line Railroad came to Baker City in 1884, prompting growth; by 1900 it was the largest city between Salt Lake City and Portland and a trading center for a broad region.

We will then re-board the motor coach for our trip home as we end our "Wild West Getaway". (B)

*The underground tunnels do not have an elevator and consist of a narrow stairwell with \sim 90 steps. Floors are uneven and there are limited benches for resting.

LEVEL 1:

I like to keep walking to a minimum and avoiding stairs when I can. I can walk up to a mile per day over primarily level ground with short periods of standing.

LEVEL 2:

I'm comfortable walking one to two miles throughout the day. I expect to get on and off a motor coach, and I'm ready to stroll through cities and walk over uneven pavement. I can stand for up to 30 minutes and climb one to two flights of stairs.

LEVEL 3:

I like to spend much of the day exploring and be out and about on a coach with my days full. I can walk two to three miles per day and stand for long periods of time with no difficulty. Stairs don't bother me, and I love to keep up with the group.

LEVEL 4:

I am a fit traveler and am capable of easily walking three miles or more during the day. I would like my days to be filled with active pursuits for one to three hours at a time. I can walk on uneven and rocky terrain, including small hills.

LEVEL 5:

Walking is the best way to get to know a new place. I'm energetic and enjoy a challenge. I'm always ready to spend the day on the move. I am fine with uneven surfaces, inclines, stair climbing, windy or wet conditions at sites, and long periods of standing. I expect some of the experiences to occur in the evening with very long days.

Wild West Getaway has an activity **LEVEL of 4**.
