September 23 – 28, 2023

Day One: Saturday, September 23 – Baker City, Oregon



Begin our motorcoach tour by stopping throughout Southern Idaho to pick up fellow club members. Eastern Idaho and Mini-Cassia members will have lunch on their own in Twin Falls before picking up Magic Valley and Treasure Valley members. You will then make your way to the Geiser Grand Hotel in Baker City, Oregon. The evening is yours to relax at the hotel and enjoy dinner on your own.

Day Two: Sunday, September 24 – Walla Walla, Washington (B, L)

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll travel towards Walla Walla, Washington. On the way, you'll stop at the only sparkling winery in Walla Walla, Yellowhawk. Enjoy a fun food and wine pairing with beautiful views overlooking the grounds. You will then make your way to a downtown winery to be determined. After, check into your room at the historic Marcus Whitman Hotel. The evening is yours to visit more downtown wineries, shop, enjoy the hotel, and have dinner on your own.



Day Three: Monday, September 25 – Walla Walla, Washington (B, L, D)

Breakfast is included at your hotel this morning before boarding the motorcoach. Make your way to the Fort Walla Walla Museum located on the grounds of a 19th-century military fort. This museum features a 17-building historic settlement, beautiful gardens, and many exhibits including a stagecoach, the oldest locomotive to operate in Washington State, and stories from the Oregon Trail. Enjoy a boxed lunch at the museum. Arrive at Waterbrook Winery early afternoon for a private tasting. You'll have time to relax inside or on the patio of this beautiful vineyard and take in the views of the Blue Mountains and tranquil surroundings. The afternoon is yours to explore downtown Walla Walla or maybe visit the historic Kirkman House. Dinner will be included together at the hotel this evening.



Day Four: Tuesday, September 26 – Leavenworth, Washington (B, D)

After breakfast at the hotel, travel to Leavenworth, Washington. You will arrive early afternoon in time for lunch on your own with the afternoon to explore the beautiful town. Experience the Nutcracker Museum, shop for fun souvenirs, visit one of the many restaurants or brewries, or just stroll the beautiful streets and enjoy the bavarian charm. Dinner will be included at an authentic German Restaurant this evening.



Day Five: Wednesday, September 27 – Leavenworth to Pendleton, Oregon (B, L)

Breakfast is included at the Bavarian Lodge this morning. The rest of the morning is yours to continue exploring. We will have lunch together before we board the motorcoach for the Wildhorse Casino in Pendleton, Oregon. You will have the evening to explore the resort, dip in the pool, enjoy a show, or gamble. Dinner is on your own this evening.



Day Six: Thursday, September 28 – Home (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, make your way to Boise and bid farewell to the Treasure Valley members. A lunch stop will be made in Boise for lunch on your own before we say farewell and head home.

LEVEL 1:

I like to keep walking to a minimum and avoiding stairs when I can. I can walk up to a mile per day over primarily level ground with short periods of standing.

LEVEL 2:

I'm comfortable walking one to two miles throughout the day. I expect to get on and off a motor coach, and I'm ready to stroll through cities and walk over uneven pavement. I can stand for up to 30 minutes and climb one to two flights of stairs.

LEVEL 3:

I like to spend much of the day exploring and be out and about on a coach with my days full. I can walk two to three miles per day and stand for long periods of time with no difficulty. Stairs don't bother me, and I love to keep up with the group.

LEVEL 4:

I am a fit traveler and am capable of easily walking three miles or more during the day. I would like my days to be filled with active pursuits for one to three hours at a time. I can walk on uneven and rocky terrain, including small hills.

LEVEL 5:

Walking is the best way to get to know a new place. I'm energetic and enjoy a challenge. I'm always ready to spend the day on the move. I am fine with uneven surfaces, inclines, stair climbing, windy or wet conditions at sites, and long periods of standing. I expect some of the experiences to occur in the evening with very long days.
