Prince Kristian Fjord surrounds you with towering cliffs and drifting icebergs. Paamiut's bright wooden houses and Inuit traditions offer a warm contrast to the Arctic surroundings. In Nuuk, participate in a Kaffemik, a traditional Greenlandic social gathering in a local resident's home. Before returning to Reykjavik, experience a panoramic view of Narsaq's emerald valleys and icy fjords on a helicopter tour.



ITINERARY

August 7: Boise, Idaho - Depart for Iceland

Depart Boise for Reykjavik. Overnight travel will be required for August 8, 2027 arrival.

August 8: Reykjavik, Iceland - Embark 1pm

Following transfer to pier, embark in Reykjavik, Iceland's vibrant capital, where colorful buildings and modern Nordic design stand alongside historic harbor streets.

August 9: Heimaey, Iceland

Heimaey, the only inhabited island in the Westman archipelago, carries the dramatic legacy of the 1973 volcanic eruption that reshaped its landscape. Visitors often explore the Eldheimar Museum or hike volcanic slopes that still bear the marks of that event.

August 10: Grundarfjordur, Iceland

Grundarfjordur rests alongside Iceland's Snæfellsnes Peninsula beneath the distinctive peak of Kirkjufell. Nearby waterfalls and coastal walking paths reveal why this small town fishing town is often considered one of Iceland's most photographed landscapes.

August 11: Isafjordur, Iceland

Isafjordur sits deep within Iceland's remote Westfjords, surrounded by steep mountains and narrow fjords. The town's wooden merchant houses and maritime museum recall centuries of fishing culture in one of the country's most isolated coastal regions.

August 12: Cruising the Atlantic Ocean

A day crossing the North Atlantic offers time to relax on deck and enjoy the ship's amenities. Open waters, seabirds, and shifting northern skies create a sense of scale along the sea routes once followed by explorers and trading vessels.

Grundarfjordur, Iceland

August 13: Prince Kristian Fjord, Greenland

Cruise through Prince Christian Sound, where towering granite cliffs and drifting icebergs line Greenland's southern coast. This narrow fjord has dramatic views of glaciers, waterfalls, and rugged mountains rarely seen outside the Arctic.

August 14: Paamiut (Frederikshab), Greenland

Paamiut is a small coastal town where humpback whales are often spotted during summer months. Colorful wooden houses and small fishing boats line the harbor, recalling the town's long history as a fishing settlement.

August 15: Nuuk, Greenland

Nuuk blends contemporary Arctic life with deep Inuit traditions. Founded in the 18th century as a Danish colonial settlement, it now serves as Greenland's capital and remains central to the island's political and cultural life.

August 16: Narsaq, Greenland

Narsaq lies within southern Greenland's most lush region, where sheep farms and small settlements dot the surrounding valleys. Nearby Norse ruins recall the era when Viking settlers established farming communities along these southern fjords.

August 17-18: Cruising the Atlantic Ocean

Another day at sea offers time to reflect on your journey while enjoying life on board. Lounges, observation decks, and quiet corners invite relaxation as the ship traces its course back to Iceland.

August 19: Reykjavik, Iceland - Disembark 8am

Return to Reykjavik, where the city's harbor and surrounding volcanic landscapes bring the voyage full circle.
