Day One – Saturday, September 25: Welcome to Boston! (D)

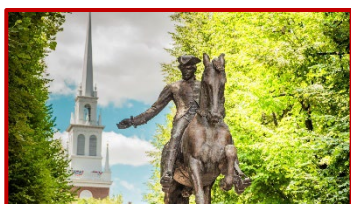
Day Two – Sunday, September 26: Historic Boston & Boston Tea Party (B, D)

During a guided city tour, we'll explore portions of the famous Freedom Trail and see many of Boston's most treasured landmarks, including the Old State House, Boston Common, Public Garden, and Faneuil Hall. We'll enjoy free time for lunch and shopping at vibrant Quincy Market, where historic architecture meets an exciting collection of boutiques, restaurants, street performers, and local vendors. This afternoon, history comes to life as we participate in an interactive reenactment of the legendary Boston Tea Party. Join fellow patriots as we relive one of the most pivotal moments in American history—and yes, we'll even help toss tea into Boston Harbor!



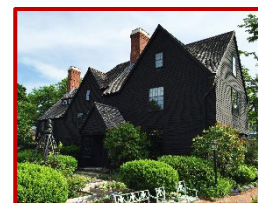
Day Three – Monday, September 27: Lexington & Concord – the Road to Revolution (B, D)

Travel back to April 1775 as we trace the events leading to the "Shot Heard 'Round the World" and the beginning of the American Revolution. Our day begins in Boston's historic North End, where we'll visit the area surrounding Paul Revere's home and the famed Old North Church, where two lanterns signaled the approach of British troops. Following Revere's legendary route into the countryside, we'll journey to Lexington and Concord, where brave colonial Minutemen stood their ground against British forces. After a fascinating day of exploration, we'll return to Boston with time to relax before dinner.



Day Four – Tuesday, September 28: Salem, Gloucester & Rockport (B, D)

Today we venture north along Massachusetts' scenic coastline to discover some of New England's most captivating seaside communities. Our first stop is Salem, famous for the infamous Witch Trials of 1692 and its enchanting blend of history and mystery. We'll visit the Salem Witch Museum and explore the city's historic streets lined with beautiful colonial architecture, maritime landmarks, and centuries-old cemeteries. We'll then continue to the iconic House of the Seven Gables, immortalized by author Nathaniel Hawthorne, before traveling along the rugged North Shore to Gloucester, one of America's oldest fishing ports. Our coastal journey continues through the elegant "Gold Coast" before arriving in picturesque Rockport, a charming artists' colony known for its galleries, boutiques, and harbor views. Don't forget your camera—this is home to the famous Motif No. 1, one of the most photographed buildings in America. Tonight, we'll gather for a special dinner as our last night in Boston.



Day Five – Wednesday, September 29: From Boston to Coastal Maine (B, Lobster Lunch)

Enjoy a leisurely morning in Boston before we depart for the breathtaking coast of Maine. Sleep in, take a stroll through the city, or enjoy a relaxing breakfast at your own pace before we begin our next adventure. Upon arriving in Maine, we'll savor a traditional Maine lobster feast complete with all the classic trimmings. We'll then visit one of New England's most iconic landmarks—Nubble Lighthouse at Cape Neddick. Perched dramatically atop a rocky island just offshore, this picturesque lighthouse offers spectacular photo opportunities and unforgettable coastal views. Later, we'll explore the charming seaside village of Kennebunkport, known for its quaint shops, beautiful harbor, and Walker's Point, the longtime summer home of President George H.W. Bush. This evening we'll settle into our coastal Maine hotel for a two-night stay and enjoy dinner on our own.



Day Six – Thursday, September 30: Authentic Coastal Maine Experiences (B, D)

Today is all about experiencing life on Maine's rugged and beautiful coastline. We'll learn firsthand about the region's fishing heritage, discovering how lobstermen harvest one of New England's most prized treasures. Next, we'll dive into Maine's thriving oyster culture with a hands-on oyster shucking demonstration and tasting experience. This afternoon, we'll take to the water for a scenic cruise through beautiful Casco Bay, where islands, working harbors, and stunning coastal scenery showcase the very best of Maine. It's a day filled with authentic experiences, unforgettable views, and memories that will last a lifetime.



Day Seven – Friday, October 1: Journey Home (B)

After breakfast, we'll bid farewell to New England and travel to Boston's Logan International Airport for our flight home. As we depart, we'll take with us treasured memories of Revolutionary history, charming coastal villages, fresh-from-the-sea cuisine, and the timeless beauty of Boston and Maine.

Premier Club tours are assigned activity ratings from level 1 to level 5. Please consider the following statements and at what level you are comfortable traveling when booking your tour:

LEVEL 1:

I like to keep walking to a minimum and avoiding stairs when I can. I can walk up to a mile per day over primarily level ground with short periods of standing.

LEVEL 2:

I'm comfortable walking one to two miles throughout the day. I expect to get on and off a motor coach, and I'm ready to stroll through cities and walk over uneven pavement. I can stand for up to 30 minutes and climb one to two flights of stairs.

LEVEL 3:

I like to spend much of the day exploring and be out and about on a coach with my days full. I can walk two to three miles per day and stand for long periods of time with no difficulty. Stairs don't bother me, and I love to keep up with the group.

LEVEL 4:

I am a fit traveler and am capable of easily walking three miles or more during the day. I would like my days to be filled with active pursuits for one to three hours at a time. I can walk on uneven and rocky terrain, including small hills.

LEVEL 5:

Walking is the best way to get to know a new place. I'm energetic and enjoy a challenge. I'm always ready to spend the day on the move. I am fine with uneven surfaces, inclines, stair climbing, windy or wet conditions at sites, and long periods of standing. I expect some of the experiences to occur in the evening with very long days.
