To complete the day, we have a beautiful evening experience at Bloomriver Hollow in Ririe, Idaho. We will have a delicious catered dinner followed by a hands-on floral experience with your own special bouquet to take home!

We will pick you up and drop you off at whichever location along the way is closest to your home.

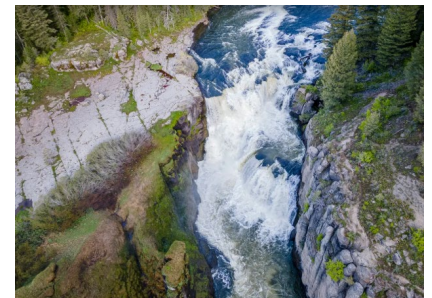

Featured Stops...

1:20 PM Arrive at Lower Mesa Falls for a sack lunch while enjoying the falls. [Idaho State Hwy (Mesa Falls Scenic Byway) to Forest Road 348]

Lower Mesa Falls is a 65-foot waterfall on the Henrys Fork in Fremont County, Idaho. It is in the Caribou-Targhee National Forest on the Mesa Falls Scenic Byway. It is a thunderous curtain of water that pours over remnants of an ancient volcanic super-eruption. The river continually chiseling away at all the solidified ash and lava. The beautiful Upper and Lower Mesa Falls are the last prominent waterfalls on the Snake River unaffected by manmade influences.

**2:45 PM Arrive at Big Springs and walk to Johnny Sack Cabin (46 Hwy 30, Ashton, ID 83420)
Enjoy the crystal-clear springs, feed the trout, and explore the historic cabin.**



Johnny Sack Cabin is a historic hand-built log cabin located at Big Springs in Island Park, Idaho, featuring unique woodwork, a waterwheel, and crystal-clear river views.

The Johnny Sack cabin is architecturally and artistically significant for its distinctive craftsmanship. It is widely recognized locally as a landmark and generally acknowledged to be the finest building in the Big Springs area of Island Park. It is the work of a master craftsman, and concern for its preservation has been expressed locally by the Madison County Historical Society. As an example of the bungalow mode applied to log construction, the Sack cabin has more than local significance, however, and should be preserved.

5:00 PM Arrive at Bloomriver Hollow (4549 E 250 N, Rigby, ID 83442).

Located in a secluded hollow along the banks of the South Fork, our boutique flower farm offers fresh, locally grown blooms and memorable, hands-on experiences. Bloomriver Hollow is an enchanting cut-flower farm in Ririe, Idaho that is widely known as a scenic woodland sweet pea haven along the Snake River. It was recently featured on the Southeast Idaho Garden Tour.

Dinner will be provided by “Catered Your Way” at the Bloomriver Hollow. It will include Potato Salad, Green Salad, Baked Beans, Chuckwagon Corn, Fresh Watermelon, Grilled Hamburgers and Hot Dogs, BBQ Chicken, Apple or Cherry Crisp and Whip Cream.
