No substitutes will be considered.* Scholarship applications may be considered for the following:

1. Individuals or students continuing their education at an accredited college or vocational school.
2. Senior high students applying for admission to accredited college or vocational school.

The deadline for receiving applications for both categories is **March 31, 2025.**

Applications must be postmarked or delivered to the Benson or O'Malley Branch by March 31, 2025 no later than 6:00 P.M. In order to be fair to all applicants the information requested must be received with the application in order for the applicant to be eligible for a scholarship award.

Eligibility:

The scholarship must be used to help fund college tuition at an accredited college or licensed/certified vocational program. Northern Skies Federal Credit Union employees, board members, supervisory committee members and their children are not eligible for the scholarship.

All applicants will be notified in writing of the results no later than June 1, 2025 . The decision of the committee is final and deliberations regarding scholarship applicants will remain confidential.



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THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA WILL BE USED TO GRANT SCHOLARSHIPS

- The applicant must be a member or a child of a member of Northern Skies FCU for at least one year by March 31, 2024.
- Student must show financial need.
- Good academic record.
- Record of community involvement.
- Extra-curricular activities
- Student must state future plans/goals.

In addition to filling out the application, the applicant must include:

A letter of application outlining the following:

- (a) Personal history - Information about your family; something about yourself, or experiences you would like to share.
- (b) Future plans for education - Why you wish to go to college or trade school, major field of interest, and school that you plan to attend.
- (c) Previous education - Include membership in organizations in and out of school, offices held, and honors accorded to you.
- (d) Plans for financing college education and why you need financial assistance.

Two letters of recommendation including at least one letter from a person who is **not connected with the school**.

Transcript which will be supplied by the Registrar in your Counseling Center.

SAT/ACT/Placement Scores

College budget or financial statement

Submission of a 500-word written essay (double-spaced) or a 60 second YouTube video.

(YouTube link should be emailed to marketing@nsfcu.org by the scholarship deadline).

Essay or video should be based on the following theme: Passion and Purpose

We need purpose in our lives to feel fulfilled, and to help us make a difference in the world. What is your personal mission statement? How do you plan to make an impact in the world or your community?

Copies of newspaper articles and other materials concerning honors and activities you have participated in during recent years. (Optional.)
