




Protect Yourself Against Fraud This Holiday Season

Annual Meeting and Election

Our 2025 election will be carried out by mail ballot (should there be additional qualified candidates) and will fill three 3-year term positions on the Board of Directors. If necessary, ballots will be mailed to members in January. Election results will be announced at the 2025 Annual Meeting scheduled for Thursday, March 20, 2025.

- Marva Luhrs Marva is retired from the Anchorage School District and worked in accounting in public and private sectors for more than 45 years. She has been a member of Northern Skies for 48 years and has served the credit union for more than 39 years on the Credit Committee, Supervisory Committee, and the Board of Directors.
- Merri Shunk As a retired senior accountant, Merri has held various positions at a local co-op since 1991. She has been a Northern Skies member since 1995 and has served on our Supervisory Committee and Board of Directors for over 17 years collectively.
- **Ellen Gamel** Ellen has been a member of Northern Skies for 49 years and has served on the Board of Directors for 24. Now retired, she served the Anchorage School District for more than 30 years, most recently as the Administrative Assistant at Willard Bowman Elementary School.

Other members interested in becoming candidates can qualify by the petition method. Official petition forms must be used and will be available on December 20, 2024, by calling the credit union at (907) 561-1407. The signatures and account numbers of at least 1% of members are required in order to qualify as a candidate by the petition method. Petitions must be returned to the credit union by 5 p.m. on February 8, 2025. If no additional candidates qualify by petition, the slate of candidates will remain as proposed by the Nominating Committee. If there is only one candidate for each position, the election will not be conducted by mail ballot and, as long as there is at least one candidate for each position, there will be no floor nominations.
