Eligible Applicants Must:

- Be a prime member in good standing of MountainCrest Credit Union for a minimum of 90 days prior to application, or son/daughter of a prime member.
- Be accepted or enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical school.

All Applicants Must Submit:

- A completed MountainCrest Credit Union scholarship application.
- A completed essay.
- Most recent transcripts/records from your high school, college or technical school.
- Notice of acceptance or enrollment to chosen post secondary school.

MountainCrest Credit Union will send the scholarship funds directly to the Financial Aid office at the recipient’s chosen school.

Scholarship applications must be submitted to MountainCrest Credit Union by **April 30, 2024**.
Winners will be notified no later than May 31, 2024.
