

THE GRACE AND ROY JORDAN SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The purpose of the Grace and Roy Jordan Scholarship Fund is to inspire and encourage able students of Lancaster High School, Lancaster, Virginia, to strive for further education upon their graduation from high school and to assist students in need of financial aid to realize their educational goals.

Eligibility (Must meet one of the following criteria)

- Graduating Senior of Lancaster High School
- Alumna/Alumnus of Lancaster High School who is furthering their education
- Past attendee of Lancaster High School with their General Equivalency Diploma (GED) who is furthering their education

Criteria

- Scholarship recipients must be high school graduates (including General Equivalency Diploma recipients)
- The need for financial assistance
- Participation in extracurricular activities (school and community) may be taken into consideration
- Evaluations and recommendations by the high school counselor, other faculty and administrative personnel
- Community references
- The maintenance of a creditable grade point average (GPA) in light of outside job work load and the academic standards of educational institution attended
- Accepted to a college, technical school or vocational institute

Application Process (Applicant must submit)

1. Completed application form.
2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee of the Grace and Roy Jordan Scholarship Fund containing a brief explanation of your career goals and financial need.
3. List of all extracurricular activities.
4. List honors and awards received (indicate name, date and reason award was given).
5. One (1) letter of recommendation.
6. Submit a transcript, if you are currently attending an institution other than Lancaster High School.

The Scholarship Committee is comprised of members of Lancaster High School faculty and the trustee of the Grace and Roy Jordan Scholarship Fund. This scholarship committee selects the recipients for this scholarship.

All scholarship payments will be made directly to the educational institution.
