You will want to bring your binoculars and cameras for sure.

Sadly, we depart the island today and head to Montreal, but not before an amazing stop at Montmorency Falls. Witness the power and beauty of the Falls Park. These magnificent Falls are 275 feet high, that is 98 feet higher than Niagara Falls. Again, you will not want to forget your cameras.

The following day, you will enjoy a guided tour of Montreal. You will delight in Montreal's Old World charm. The second-largest city in Canada, Montreal has much to see and do.

One of the highlights in Montreal, is the Notre-Dame Basilica. Built in 1672, the Basilica was constructed in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary and possesses some of the finest Gothic architecture in North America. Today it is an important Catholic sanctuary with 350 years of history, key architectural features and many beautiful works of art.

After breakfast today, you will visit the 1000 Islands Tower in Lansdowne, ON. After dinner, you will check into an en route hotel.
