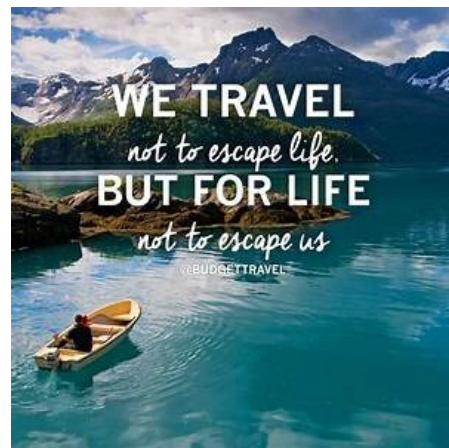

You begin your 9-day tour with an overnight flight to Turin. Upon arrival you will enjoy a luxury two-night stay in the heart of this city. The first night in Turin you will enjoy a welcome dinner with fellow travelers.

The next day, you will enjoy a guided city walking tour. This evening there is an optional tour that will take you to a 17th-century palace opened exclusively for you, Palazzo Falletti di Barolo. You will discover the elaborate frescoes and admire the royal décor to the sound of music played for you where young Mozart performed at the age of 14.

Next, you will spend a couple of nights in the Italian Riviera. You will travel through wine country to the hilltop village of La Morra on your way to a tasting. After lunch, you will continue to Sestri Levante.

After your guided tour, you will continue on through the rolling Tuscan hills for a charming 3-night stay at a traditional Italian estate. This evening, you will have to try your hand at pasta making with an interactive demonstration with your villa’s chef.

The next morning, you will have the chance to explore Florence (UNESCO), the “Cradle of the Renaissance” during a guided walking city tour. The tour will include the Ponte Vecchio, the only Florentine bridge to survive WWII, the Palazzo Vecchio, the Piazza della Signoria and Santa Croce. You will have this afternoon to explore on your own before returning to your estate.

Close your eyes and imagine a Tuscan hilltop town, That’s San Gimignano (UNESCO), overlooking the Chianti region. Its medieval towers were built as a sign of wealth in the middle ages. Today, 14 of 72 towers remain from the 12th and 13th centuries. This town is one of my personal favorites and not just because they have the world’s best authentic gelato. I loved wandering the cobbled streets, shopping and enjoying all of the sights and sounds. You will cap off the evening with a farewell dinner with friends.

Today, you will have to say ‘arrivederci’ to Italy as your adventure comes to an end.
