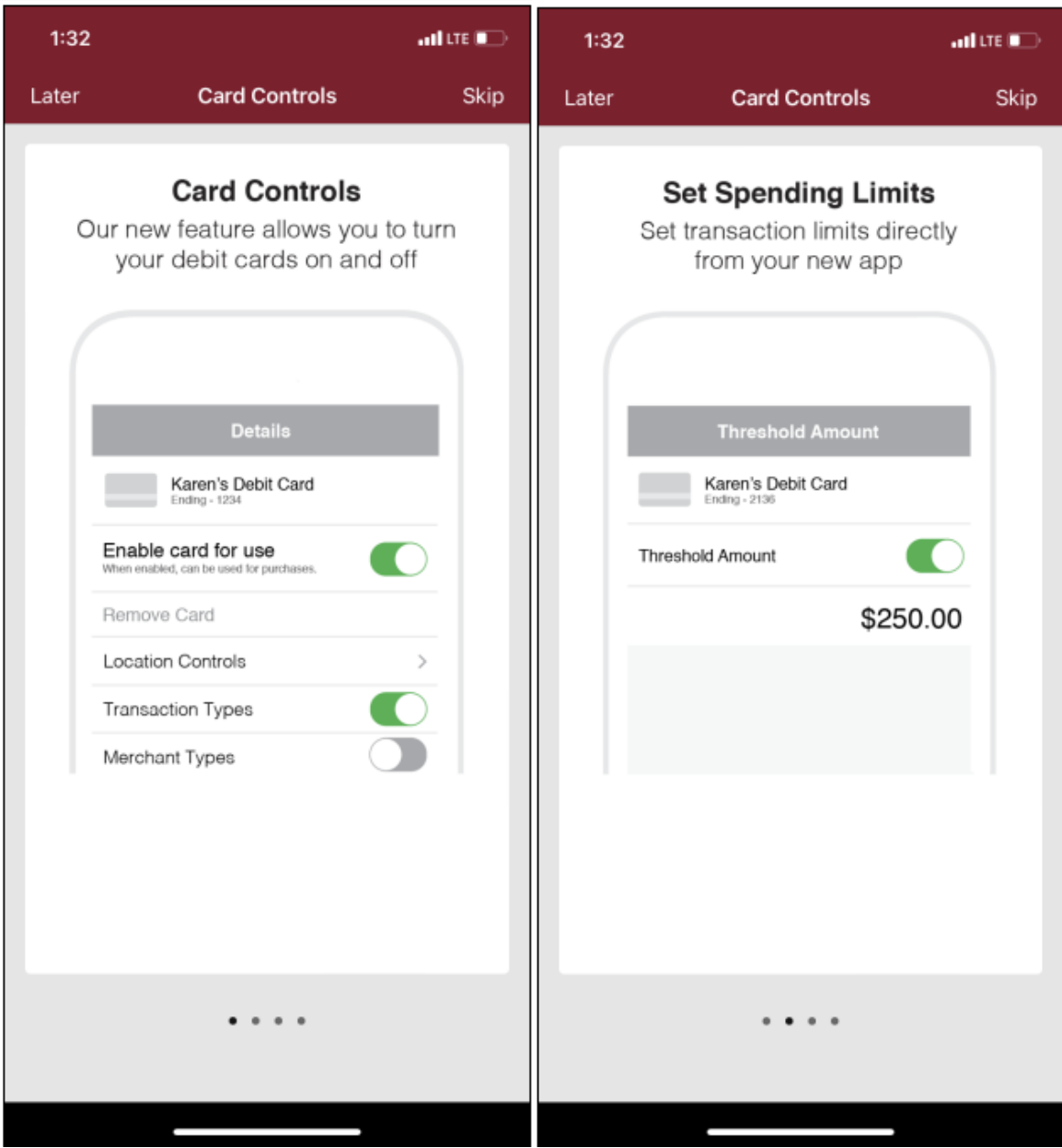
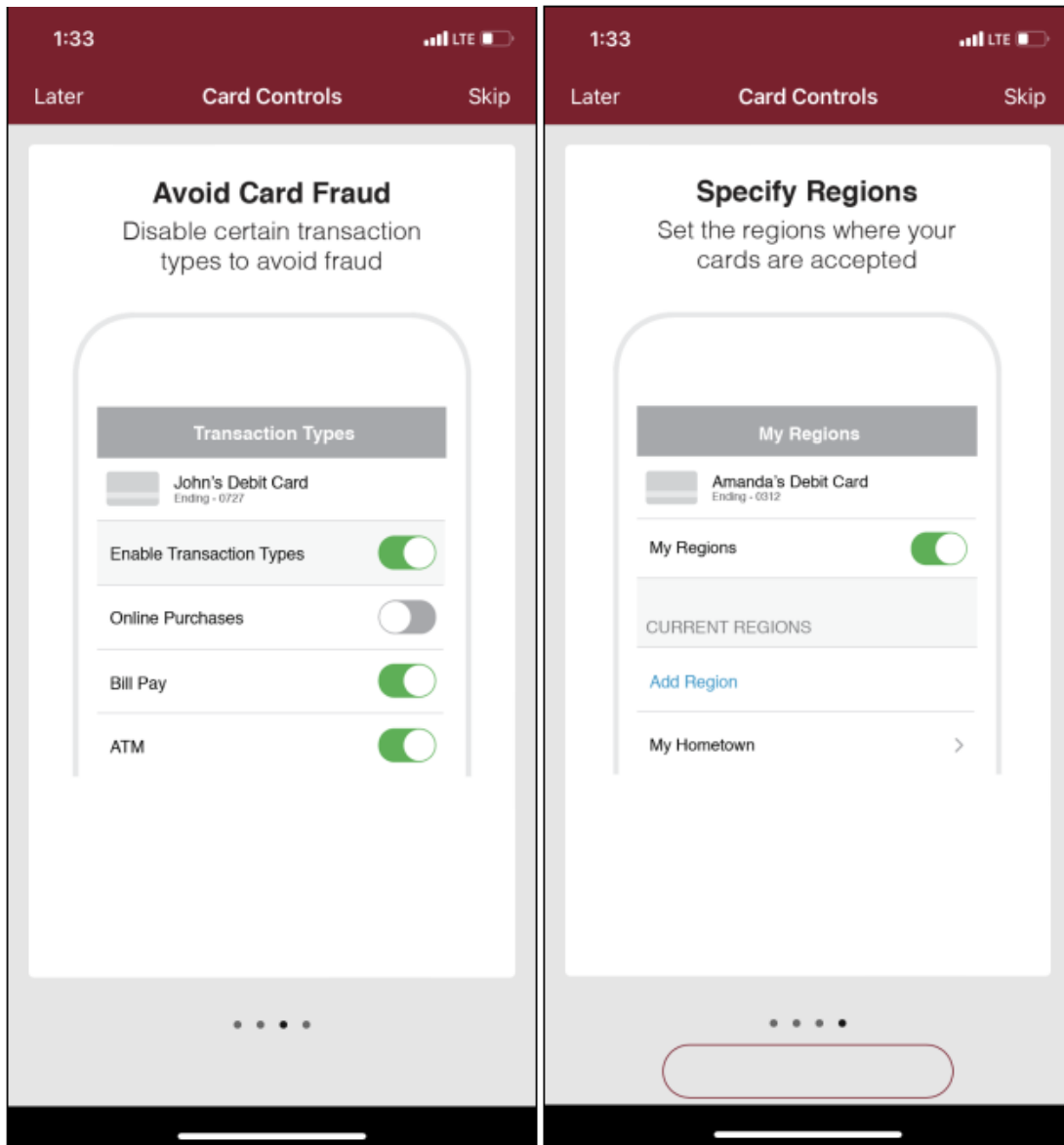

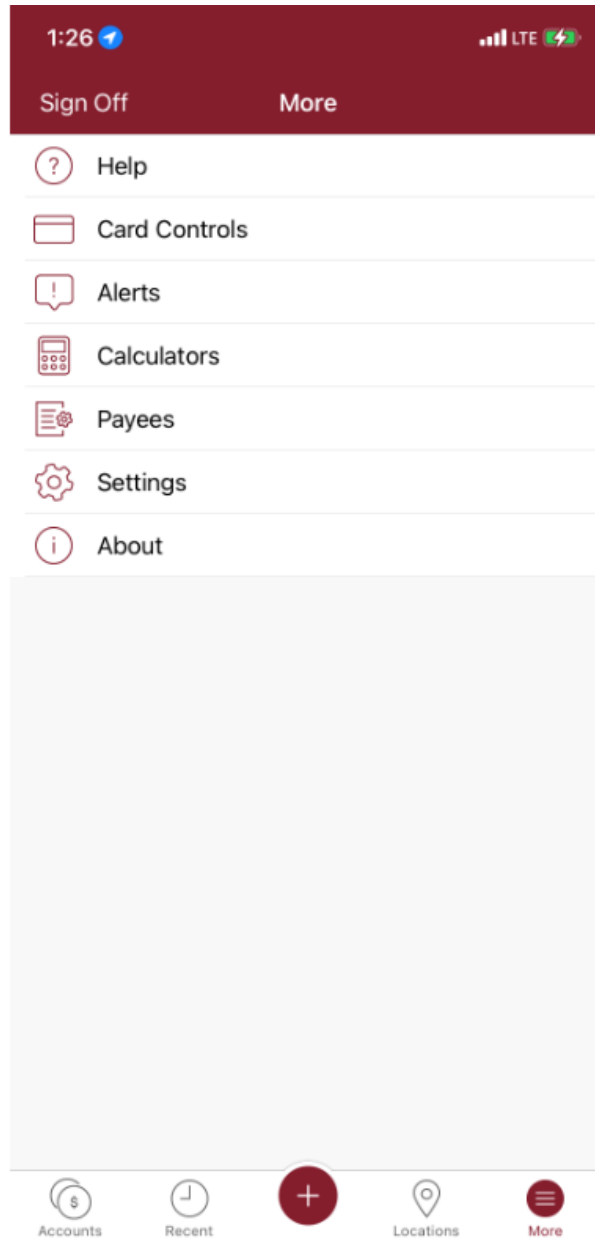


Once the screens are previewed select later or skip.

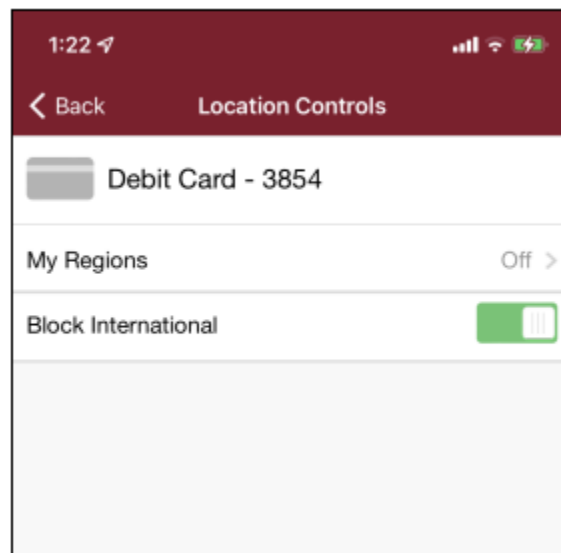


Location Controls:

 - You must create the nickname for each region

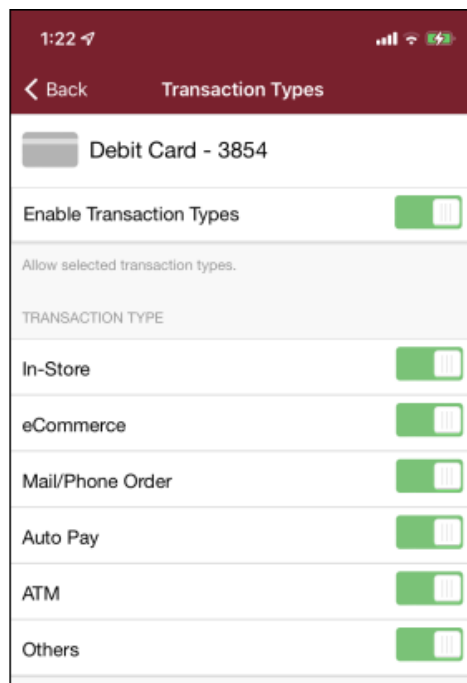


- If you have international blocked, you cannot do the region
**important to note the bank has international transactions blocked*



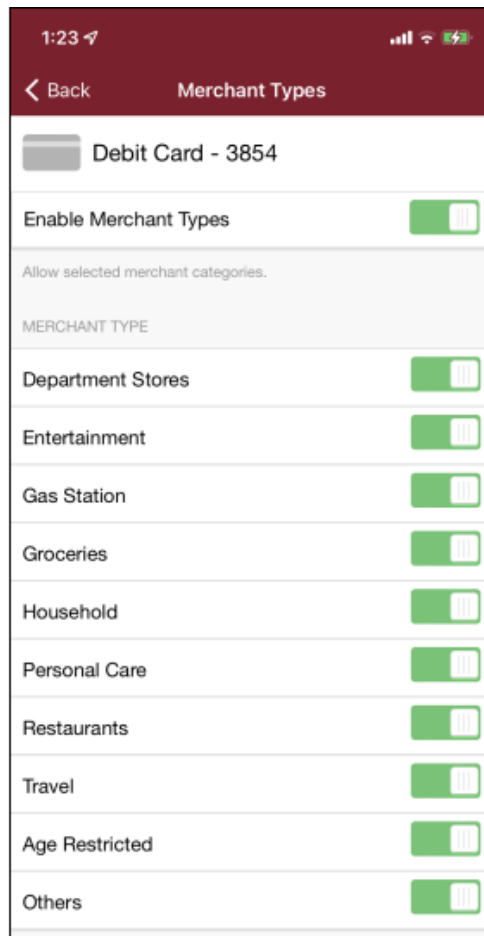
Transactions Types

- Allows you to turn on or off the types of transaction you wish to have transactions processed by your debit card

Merchant Types

- Allows you to turn on or off the types of merchants you wish to have transactions processed by your debit card
 - Department Stores
 - Entertainment
 - Gas Station
 - Groceries
 - Household
 - Personal Care
 - Restaurants
 - Travel
 - Age Restricted
 - Others



Threshold Amount

- Sets up the amount transactions are allowed up to, anything over the threshold set will be denied
