

2023 PNB Scholarship Application

Peoples National Bank has provided financial services to Southern Illinois since 1909. In keeping with the tradition of community service and commitment to the education of future civic and business leaders, Peoples National Bank has established an educational scholarship to assist high school graduates in continuing their education at a university, college, trade or vocational school. Each recipient of the Peoples National Bank scholarship will receive a \$500 scholarship.

Eligibility Criteria

The recipient will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- Positive leadership and character exhibited in both academic and extra-curricular school activities.
- Positive leadership and character exhibited in community activities.
- Full time enrollment in an accredited two/four-year college, university or trade/vocational school. (Proof of enrollment will be required for release of scholarship funds.)
- Eligible applicants must be a graduating senior of a high school within an approved market area of Peoples National Bank.
- Applicants must have maintained a "B" average or better for seven semesters of high school.
- Student/Applicant or one or both parents/guardians of student/applicant must be a customer or employee of Peoples National Bank.

Selection Process

- The Scholarship Selection Committee of Peoples National Bank will administer the application and selection process for the scholarship award.
- Applicants must submit a neatly completed application form and furnish a high school transcript for 3.5 years to verify grade point average of "B" average.
- Applicants must have the application and transcript turned in to Peoples National Bank by March 3, 2023. Submit by email to Scholarship@peoplesnationalbank.com or mail to PO Box 908, Mt. Vernon IL 62864, Attn: HR.
- The Scholarship Selection Committee will evaluate the applications and approve the selection of recipients.
- The Scholarship Winners will be announced at each participating school's Awards Program.

Scholarship Payment

- Student will supply proof of enrollment to college/university or vocational school for the 2023-2024 school years.
- Student will provide a copy of the tuition bill and/or itemized bill for book expenses, including required electronic materials.
- Scholarship funds will be released directly to the educational institution, unless submitting paid book expenses.
- Scholarship funds are not transferable and will expire July 1, 2024.
